# New Program Funds Summer Food

A new summer program called SUN Bucks will provide USDA funding for summer food for families in need.

Families who receive or qualify for free/reduced meals may benefit. If your household income is less than 185% of the Federal poverty level (\$55,500 for a family of 4, [see full chart](#)), students in your household may be eligible. Qualifying families will receive funds via an electronic bank card that can be used to buy food at grocery stores, farmer's markets, and other authorized retailers.

Funding for this program is made available by the USDA as an extension of Mooresville Schools taking part in the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program.

Those whose children are not already on free/reduced meals but fall into the guidelines should complete the Mooresville Schools Free/Reduced Meal application via [Skyward Family Access](#) or request an application from their school office. Please complete the application by the end of April to be included in the early release of the funding. Contact Mooresville Schools Food Services at 317-831-9200 with any questions regarding the application. After May 1, visit [www.indianasunbucks.com](http://www.indianasunbucks.com) to complete the application.

Mooresville Schools will again host Summer Meal sites at Neil Armstrong Elementary, Pioneer Park, and Mooresville High School. These sites provide free meals to all children under 18 years of age.

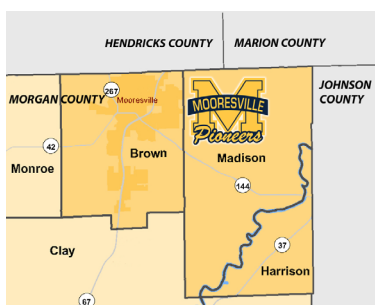
# News Briefs
