

Honoring the Class of '23

This year's senior class turned from students to alumni on Saturday, May 27. The Class of '23 was led by Valedictorian Abigail Koons and Salutatorian Alyssa Kline.

Nearly 48 percent of graduates earning Academic or Technical Honors diplomas. These students maintained at least a B average while taking a more rigorous course load including additional math, science, and world language courses. These students also earned college credits and/or industry certifications for their work while enrolled at MHS. Over 50 of MHS graduating seniors were awarded nearly \$2.5 million in scholarships to futher their education.


