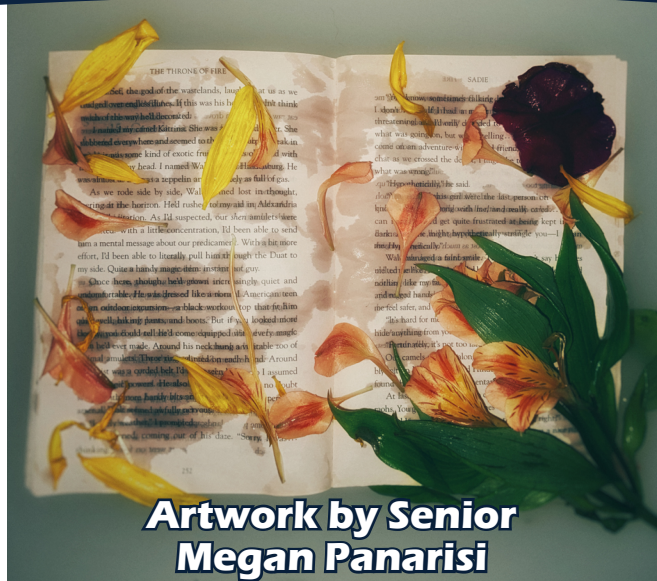

## News Briefs

**Assistance for Students in Need:** Families in need of assistance for Christmas should contact their school office, school counselor or family services coordinator for a Christmas assistance application. Applications and assistance are coordinated through Churches in Mission. Applications should be return to the Mission (27 S. Indiana St.) by Thanksgiving. Families whose children need a coat for winter should visit the Mt. Gilead Coat Distribution on Oct. 29. Learn more from the [Coat Distribution Flier](#).

**Winter Weather Reminders:** Indiana weather can be unpredictable and parents are advised to work out a “back-up plan” when school is delayed, an elearning day is announced, or schools have to close early due to weather. State law requires that schools be in session for 180 days. When there is an unscheduled school closing, the school day must be made up. Mooresville students will have eLearning days if school buildings must closed. When it is necessary to close or delay school, a message will be sent via the school Skylert system to all student households. Calls will be made prior to 6:00 a.m.
