Dixon Wins HOPE Award

MHS teacher Chet Dixon has been chosen Mooresville’s Teacher of the Year, the winner of the HOPE (Helping Our Pupils Excel) award. Dixon teaches at the MHS Pioneer Academy for Student Success, helping high school students who have struggled to regain academic credits.

“There is no doubt that today’s student needs more than just an academic instructor,” said MHS Principal Wes Upton. “They need someone who fills multiple roles ranging instructor to counselor and everything in between. Sometimes students need a little extra support to make it across the finish line. There isn’t a better teacher for providing this while also upholding strong standards academically than Chet Dixon. Chet does this seamlessly but not by accident. He spends countless hours making sure he has all the latest best practices and puts them in place. He seeks out support from community partners to make sure his students have real opportunities in and outside of school. 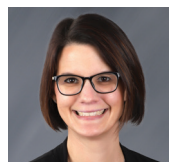
Mooresville Schools / Ivy Tech Career Center Open House Friday

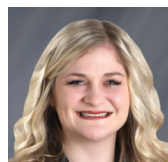

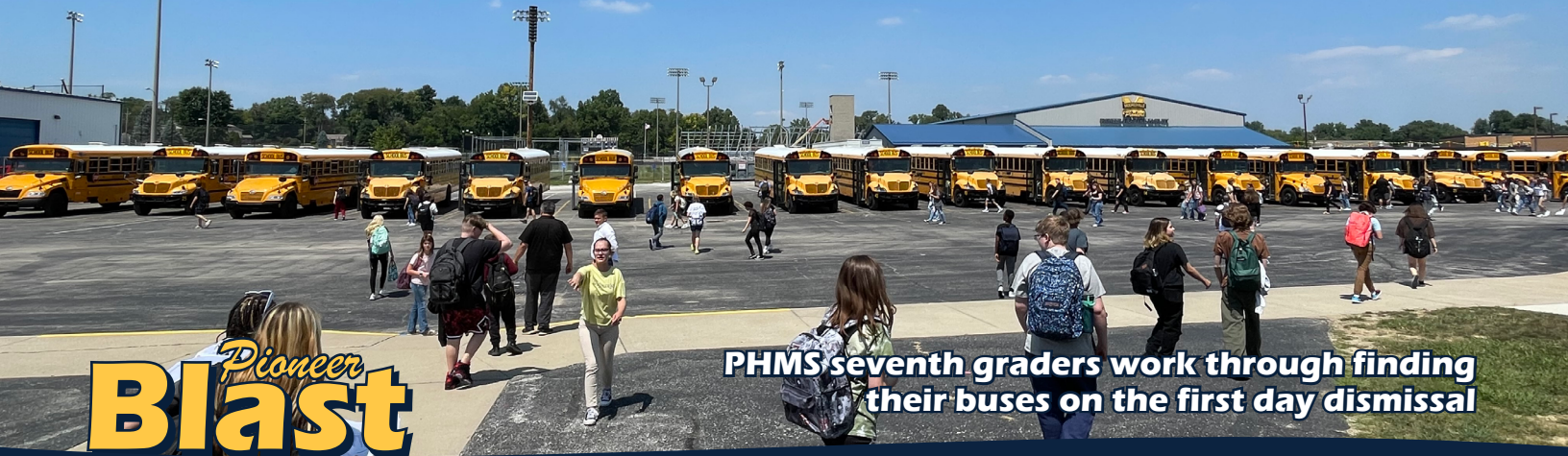

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These Neil Armstrong kindergartners have already mastered "Twin Day"

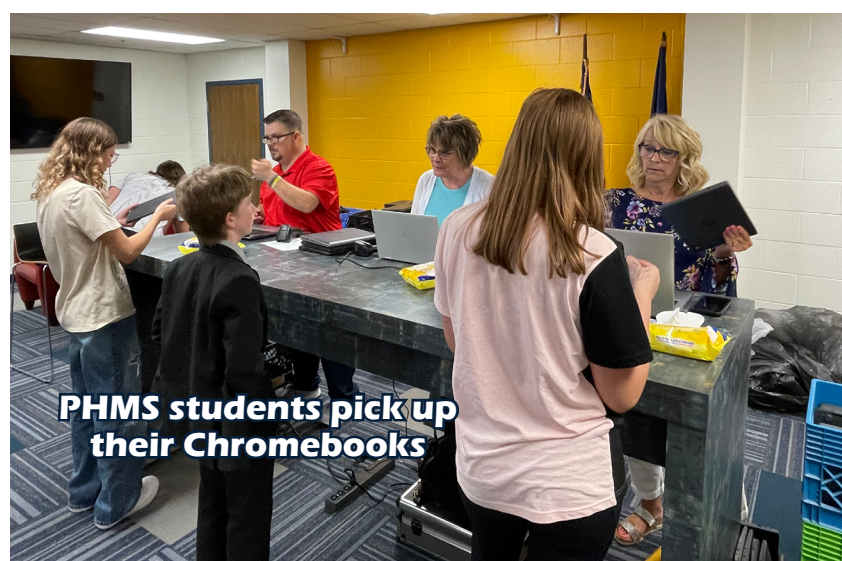

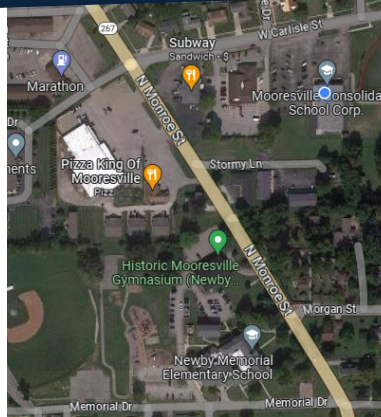


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News Briefs
