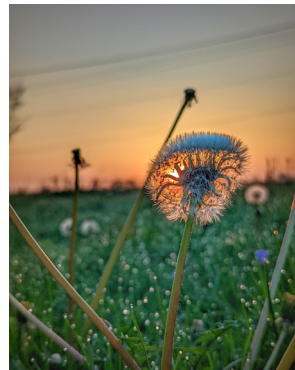
Several talented MHS photographers will have their work featured in Mooresville's 200th Anniversary 2024 Calendar.

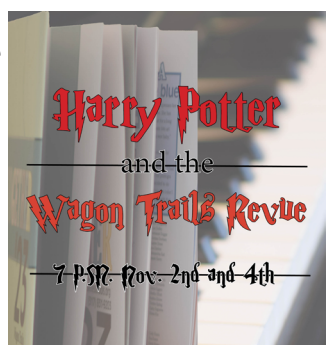
## MHS Career Fair

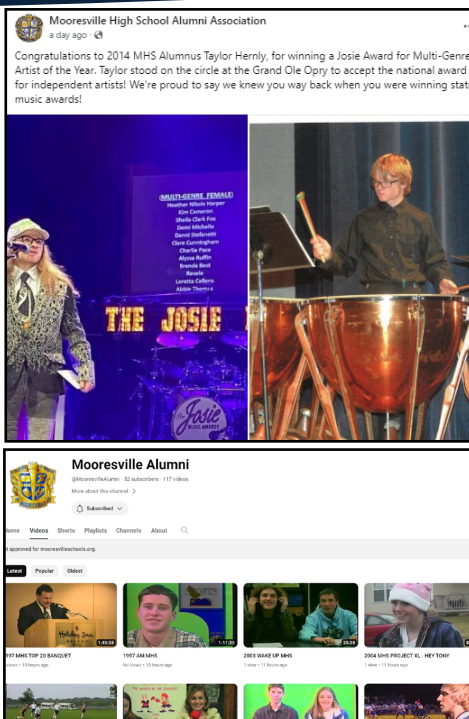
