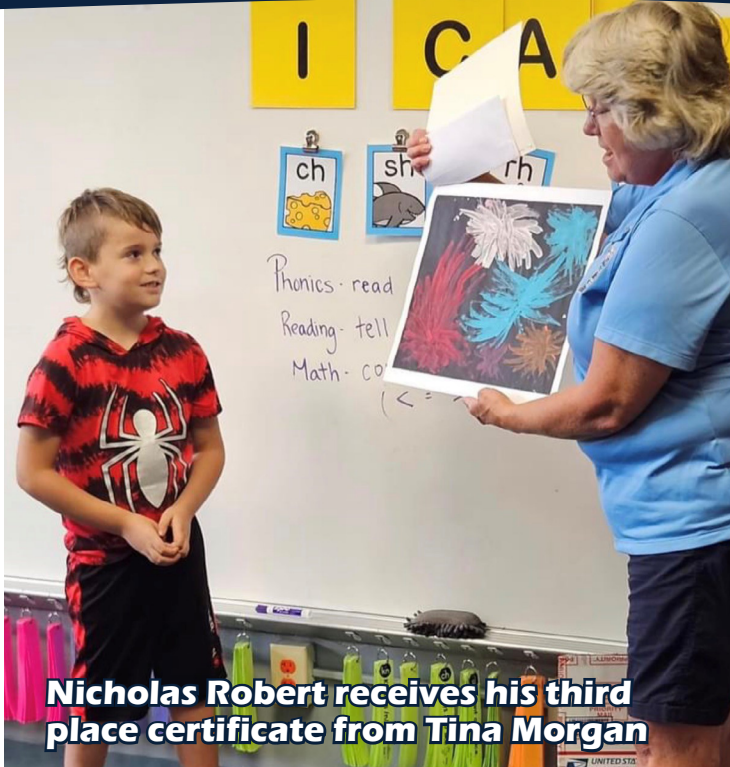

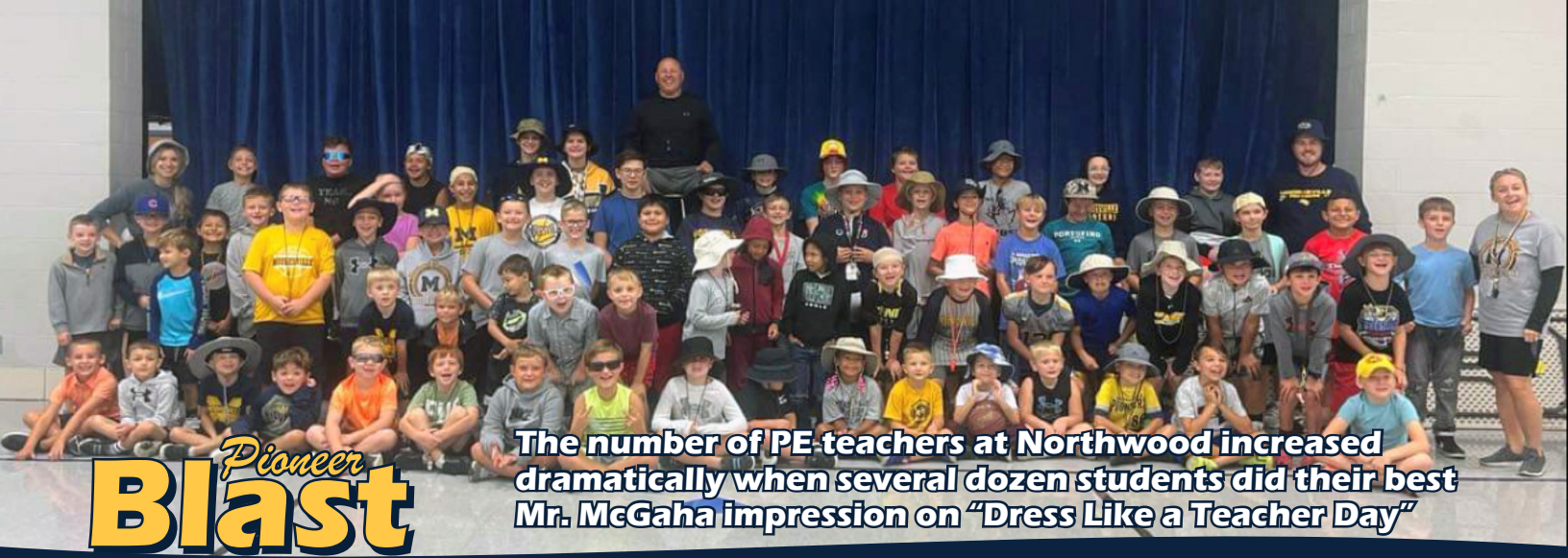

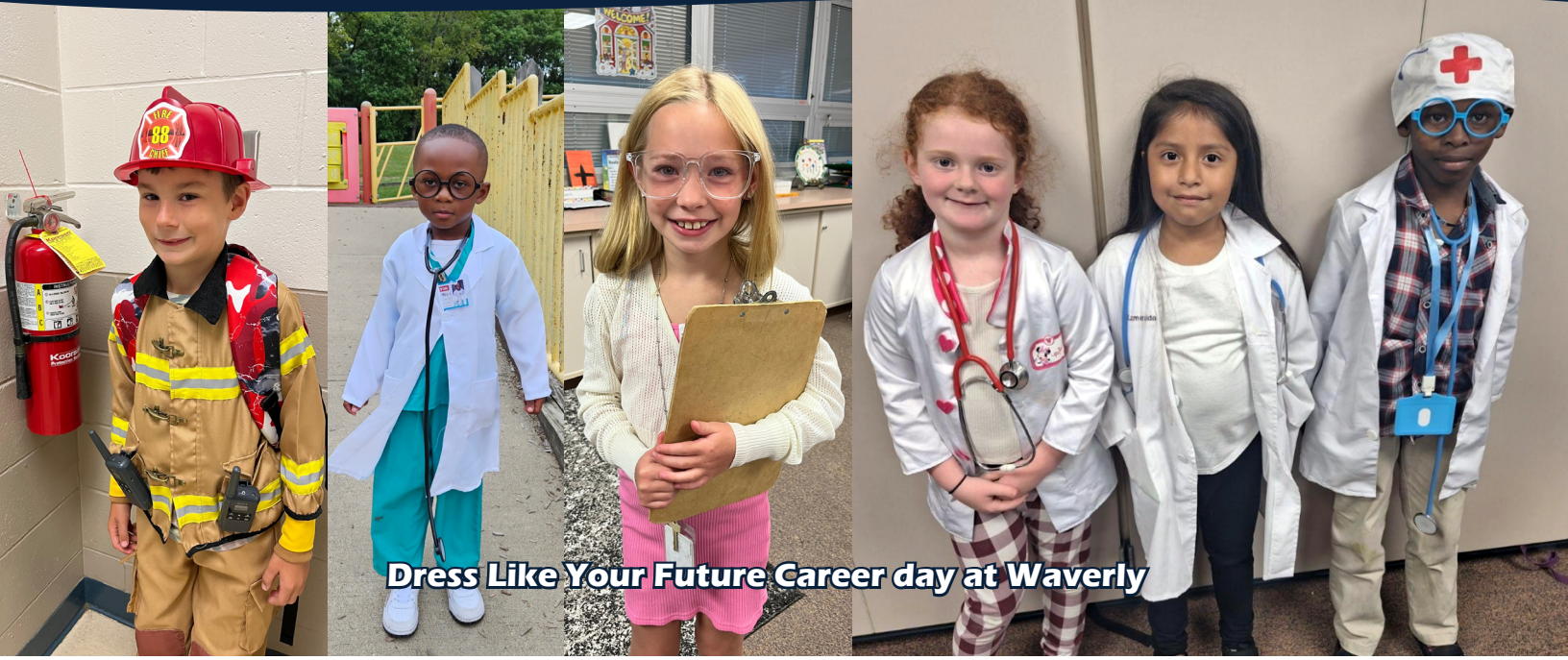

News Briefs

Football Stadium Safety: Due to large crowds attending MHS varsity football games, several safety protocols are in place. Students found playing around in the stadium will be asked to sit with their parents or in a designated section of the stands. No footballs or other sports equipment are to be brought from home for use inside the stadium. In addition, there are no "pass outs" during the game. Anyone who leaves the stadium gates must return to their vehicle or be picked up and leave campus. No one will be allowed to hang around the outside of the stadium fence, play on the Northwood playground or basketball courts, etc. These rules were made in consultation with school law enforcement and to better align with stadium rules across the Mid-State Conference.



Beware of Fake Livestream Events: Fake events for Mooresville athletic livestreams have been popping up on Facebook and other social media. These scam events may charge a fee to watch an MHS athletic event livestream that will never show. Mooresville High School athletics regular home events will only be livestreamed on [Pioneer TV](#), the official broadcast network for MHS.
